Her selection was part of a rigorous interview process that included participation from various administrative team members, teaching staff, and PTA representatives. # **Bond Referendum Planning**

After a successful meeting with leaders from many of our school community groups, we will have a referendum planning, feedback, and listening session open to all community members scheduled for December 6th at 6:30 pm in the Media Center. Attached is the most updated presentation of the scope of the projects, and we are excited to move forward with these community engagement sessions. Following last week, we are confident in support for the referendum from leadership constituents from the HT Education Association, HT Administrators' Association, Zone PTA, HT Education Foundation, HT Visual & Performing Arts Guild, HT Athletic Association, HT Mayor's Office, and more but will be asking for all community members feedback and endorsement to pass a successful referendum on March 12th, 2024. #### **Tutoring Grant**

I am happy to announce that the NJ Department of Education has accepted our grant proposal for third and fourth-grade supplemental tutoring, and we have been awarded \$115,000. Over the next few weeks, we will develop a proposal request and decide on the most effective implementation model for the supplemental support. Please join me in applauding Assistant Superintendent Mrs. Chantelle Shorter, who authored this successful grant.

### **High School Television Studio**

We are continuing to move forward with implementing a television studio at Haddon Township High School, and **all of the necessary equipment has been purchased and delivered**. At last week's Board Meeting, HTHS graduate Dom Francesconi was also approved as a project consultant and will provide hands-on technical support while we set up the new studio and equipment. Mr. Francesconi is also a recent graduate of Rowan University, where he was a member of the Rowan Television Network. We will begin utilizing the studio as part of an after-school club to introduce students to elements of television broadcasting and communication, and we are excited about the next steps of this initiative.

### **Grading Scale Update**

Also, at last week's Board Meeting, we received a significant amount of public comment regarding our high school grading scale. I want to reiterate our commitment to listening to all perspectives on this topic and the importance of collecting data, evidence, and feedback from various sources, including university admissions officers, which takes time. The most appropriate time to make **decisions** on school district policies such as this will be in the spring as we adopt district goals aligned with our budget.
