Public Hearing

Last evening, the Board of Education approved the school district budget for next year. Below is a video link to the presentation, and a pdf file for your reference is attached. The overall tax impact will be a decrease of \$235.31, which results from reduced debt services, and an increase in state aid of \$1.4M, mostly because of rising enrollment. https://youtu.be/xz7wK1sel3Y

District Goals /Budget Highlights 2023-2024

As part of the budget, three district goals were adopted;

- 1. Implement and Support High-Quality Full Day Kindergarten Instructional Program
- 2. Prioritize and Further Develop Student Learning Environments
- 3. Prioritize Community Engagement for the Future of HTSD

Other budget highlights and "Big Wins" include:

- The continuation of strong health services and school-based nursing
- Robust levels of elementary school counseling
- Implementation of industry-standard Fundations Phonics Program (Elementary)
- Implementation of I-Ready Math Curriculum (Elementary)
- Creation of Dual Use Recording/Television Studio for HTHS
- New Equipment/Investment in HTHS Science Labs
- Other priorities of the budget will include district security upgrades, HTHS courtyard cleanup and beautification, improvements to RMS outdoor basketball court, and field maintenance/improvements for HTHS baseball and Van Sciver School.
