### Broadcast

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff,

I realize that the timing of this email is not ideal, especially after our school reopening plan was recently updated, disseminated, and discussed. However, **yesterday**, the New Jersey Department of Health contacted us with updated guidance regarding travel restrictions. Based on this guidance, we will now be following the following protocols as recommended.

1. (1) *For individuals **not** fully vaccinated, a viral test should occur 3-5 after traveling outside the New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, and Delaware areas for 24 hours or longer. A self-quarantine should occur for 7 days after travel for these areas, even with a negative test result. If testing is not completed post-travel, individuals should self-quarantine for 10 days, during which remote instruction will be provided. In the case of a positive test result, please contact your school nurse.*
1. (2) *Individuals who are **fully vaccinated** should get tested 3-5 days upon return to NJ and should monitor for symptoms of covid for 14 days. No quarantine period is necessary if **NO** symptoms are present.*
