- The Creative Curriculum developmental continuum allows us to know where the child is performing in all different areas, as well as where they should be developmentally. There are goals in literacy, numeracy, social/emotional areas, and motor skill areas to name just a few.
- The color bars correspond to ages/developmental spans which helps us see your child's strengths and where they need to grow. This is a tool we use for assessment.

#### OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Preschool is a district level program
  - Students are assigned to a school building based on:
    - Age
    - Gender
    - Transportation (if eligible)
    - Other needs- (e.g. wrap-around care enrollment, available space for students, etc.)

# WRAP-AROUND CARE



- Provides our students the chance to participate in both our regular preschool academic program as well as receive wrap-around care resulting in a full day of programming...plus a whole lot of fun in between!
- Accidents happen, but your child does need to be fully potty trained before September in order to attend.
- Students should come prepared with snacks and lunch.
- The wrap-around care program runs from 8:40-12:40 (attend p.m. preschool) or 11:10-3:10 (attend a.m. preschool). Before Care and After Care are available. Registration for those programs opens in June.
  - Note: Your child must be registered for preschool in Haddon Township in order to participate.

# TUITION AND FEES INFORMATION



- Tuition for <u>preschool only</u> for the 2024-25 school year is \$4,200\*.
- Tuition for preschool AND wrap around care is \$7,900\*.

    - Deposit is not refundable after May 31, 2024

#### PARENT THOUGHTS ON OUR PRESCHOOL PROGRAM!

My daughter started in the Haddon Township Pre-K program in the spring of 2021. I knew little about the program but after seeing her struggle and in need of some extra care at her local preschool, I enrolled her at Van Sciver at the advice of a friend. I could write so much more, but here are just a few things I've been witness to or can see in Gibson since he's started Pre-K with you wonderful teachers and the incredible aids.

-Learning to share toys or an activity is one of the things my child struggled with. However, the respect and kindness Ms. Amy and Ms. Courtney showed him by explaining and demonstrating how taking turns/interactive play with others is fun, too, if not more so when working together.

-His creativity is blossoming! The art work he brings home and how excited he is to show it, to see his confidence soar is heartwarming.

-The care and thought taken in the activities made for the kids helps include them all at whichever stage they are at. All are included and not made to feel uncomfortable if they don't partake.

-My child has learned and sometimes (still needs a little reminder) that waiting your turn and being patient is a good thing. He has been more mindful of himself and others.
