Mission and Vision Work

As part of our district goals, we are working to create an updated mission and vision statement that can serve as an active touchstone for our planning and decision-making. It would also serve as a summary of our community's core values in providing a Haddon Township education. As part of this process, we are conducting work sessions with stakeholder groups across the district that include Board of Education members, administrators, staff, parents, and students. After completing these sessions with our stakeholder groups, a district committee will synthesize and finalize our recommendations.

HTEF Teacher Grants

The Haddon Township Education Foundation (HTEF) recently awarded nine teacher grants as part of their spring cycle for Haddon Township staff members. These grant awards will promote a variety of enhanced, project-based learning opportunities for students throughout the district. We appreciate all of the work that the HTEF continues to do to support our teachers and students!

Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC)

On Monday, January 28th we had our district QSAC oversight visit from the Camden County Office. The QSAC process examined our district according to the following categories:

- Instruction and Program
- Fiscal Accountability
- Governance
- Personnel
- Operations

The visit went well, although we are left without any definitive scores at this time. The QSAC team will send the scores to the state Board of Education for approval and then we will receive feedback. The County Office noted that this process may take several months.

6th Legislative District Educational Roundtable

A bimonthly superintendent roundtable group has been created by Assemblywoman Pamela Lampitt, Chair of the Assembly Education Committee. The purpose of this group is to provide input regarding local educational issues. Our first meeting was on February 19th and we shared the impact of recent legislation, as well as school funding on Haddon Township.


